2018 GCSE RESULTS

GCSE results in 2018 were again very strong, with students from all starting points making excellent progress. We expect value-added measures to be very strong when the DfE publishes the performance tables in November.

68% of students achieved passes at 9-4 in English and maths, 45% achieved passes at 9-5 in English and maths and 30% of students achieved the EBacc bench-mark (top grades in English, maths, science, geography or history, a modern foreign language) which is well above the national (24% in 2017).

The results below are the unvalidated results from August 2018 and before any adjustment for reviews of marking.
