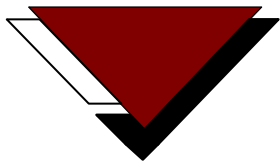
A reminder that we return to 2-2-1 structure of the day after half term. Therefore lunch will follow lesson 4 at 1.30pm.

Medical Room

- Medical room is open all day including break and lunch. We are closed for 15mins **after** break and lunch, unless you have an emergency (blood, head injuries, vomiting, fainting, injuries that may result in potential breaks/fractures and medical conditions such as asthma, anaphylaxis, diabetes, epilepsy etc).
- You must bring a signed note from your teacher to the medical room. When you return to class, you will be given a note from the medical room to take back to your teacher.
- If you come to medical during lesson changeover, you will be asked to go back to class to register and to get a note from your teacher (unless it is an emergency as listed above).
- Medical room does not give out paracetamol to students, unless this has been previously agreed with a parent/carer as part of a treatment / care plan. You are permitted to carry one dose of paracetamol (one or two tablets only) in your bag for your own occasional use (e.g for headaches or period pains).

Well done, Evelyn!

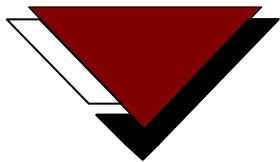

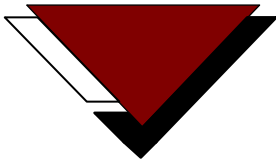
