As we look ahead to the new term, I must draw your attention to a few areas to ensure a smooth start in January.

School Uniform Policy Our approach to school uniform remains focused on providing a comfortable and relaxed environment that supports learning. However, we must ensure our standards are maintained. We remind all students that while comfort is key, items such as leggings and very short stretchy skirts are not permitted in our school uniform policy. Trousers can be flares or 'skinny' style, but we require that these have details such as pockets or zips, which means they are made of more robust, suitable material and are not sportswear. We appreciate your support in ensuring your child adheres to these clear guidelines. Letters have, and are being, sent home as reminders for some individual students who are not in the correct uniform. Full uniform details are on our website.

Mobile Phone Policy Our policy regarding mobile phones allows students to use their phones at social times across the school site. This supports our view that we want students to leave Vandyke as 'World Ready' young people, who know when it is appropriate to use a mobile phone (just as they will experience in their future workplaces). A significant part of this approach is students maintaining concentration during lesson time so they are fully present, focused, and developing critical communication skills. As part of this, we kindly ask parents and carers to please refrain from messaging your child during lesson hours. If there is an urgent matter, please contact the main school office, who will ensure the message is relayed appropriately. This simple step significantly reduces distraction and supports the positive learning environment for everyone.

Students riding bikes to and from school We are increasingly concerned about some students who are riding their bikes carelessly when arriving at, and leaving, the school site. If your child cycles to school, can you please reiterate with them the need to cycle safely. This includes looking both ways before pulling out onto the main road; not weaving in and out of cars as they slow down for the crossing lights; using both hands on the handle bars and not doing wheelies either on the pavement or as they cycle down Vandyke Road. Your support is much appreciated in this matter.
